

STANDING RULES

Revised and Adopted August 24, 2023

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- 1. Emails sent to the club using the club membership list shall be limited to subjects reasonably related to photography.
- 2. Photographs submitted for competition or exhibit purposes not claimed by the owner shall be retained for a maximum of one year from submission, after which they may be disposed of at the discretion of the corresponding chairmen.
- 3. Club-owned equipment, including, but not limited to, Projector(s), Tent(s), etc., shall be used only for club meetings and club-sponsored activities. It shall not be loaned or leased for non-club meetings or non-club-sponsored events, regardless of the requestor's membership in SWMCC.
- 4. Club-sponsored media shall be maintained in a positive and friendly manner. This includes but is not limited to the monthly newsletter, club website, Facebook page(s), and any other media administered by the Southwest Missouri Camera Club. The Secretary and Web Administrator shall enforce these standards, subject to appeal to the Executive Board. Club contact information is private and may not be used for any purpose other than club business.
- 5. Photographs containing nudity shall not be displayed on any club website or social media site or printed in the monthly newsletter of the Club.
- 6. Annual Regular Membership Dues shall be \$25; Annual Family Membership Dues shall be \$35; and Annual Junior Membership Dues (under 19 years of age) shall be \$13. Dues are reduced after July 1.
- 7. The stipend for Competition Judges shall be \$75.00 per judge per competition.
- 8. An Education Committee shall be appointed promptly after the annual meeting by the President. The committee shall comprise not more than seven (7) members in good standing. It shall be the committee's duty to assess the educational needs of the membership and identify, plan, and execute educational opportunities for the membership consistent with assessed needs.
- 9. An Audit Committee of three members, none of whom may be a member of the Executive Board, shall be appointed at the Annual Business meeting by the President. It shall be the duty of the committee to audit the Treasurer's end-of-year report and to report to the Executive Board at the first regular Executive Board meeting.
